Call to Order & Welcome

Updates

Casino -Carrie (Casino Chair)

Evergreen Theatre Residency Presentation - Ms. Glowacki

Evergreen Theatre is a performing arts group that the school would like to have come in for a 2-week residency – every class will have 5 days of participation during the residency.

Students will engage with a team of professional theatre artists to explore concepts and questions related to science curricular topics and forms of drama and movement. The work will evolve in response to student ideas. Students create the theatre performance as a class, but all connect for the performance. There will be an evening performance for families to watch.

Focus will be on ongoing work with our land-based learning with our Elders. Questions students will explore:

- How do we engage with the land to care and protect the land?
- What are our responsibilities to the land as members of the community?
- How can we continue to stay meaningfully connected to the land?

Student driven:

- Share ideas and make connections to curriculum
- Developing and deciding on story, characters, choreography, sound / music
- Engage in drama movement activities to support further learning in the classroom



Collaborative work with students, teachers, and artists

Residency booked last week of January (English program) and first week of February (French Immersion Program). Will make every effort to have French artists. Schedule is 5 days with 5th day being the day of performance. Also get to do performance for peers.

Get two free performances for students by the Evergreen Theatre Company on March 11 (AM and PM shows).

Cost is \$18,298 which includes 2 weeks residency and 2 touring show performances. Approximately \$35 per student. Significant cost – however great opportunity. Drama is a powerful way to learn and a great opportunity for the school. Asking for help to offset the cost.

Budget update

We worked with Patrick and Laura to come up with a budget that was similar to past programs. Overall, we are requesting a budget of \$35,787 for the 2023/24 school year.

- There are two new items in the budget this year one being Evergreen Theatre which was discussed earlier to which the TSES would like to decrease the overall burden and is requesting \$12,000. The other item is digital stage piano for the music room requested in the previous meeting by Mr. Chapman which has an estimated maximum cost of \$2,500. The school is not planning on having Sound Creations back and thus the estimated \$9,000 spent on that in previous years would help cover these items.
- Other items on the wish list/budget for the year are:
 - Elder Shirley visits again, budgeted for \$7,250
 - French Immersion resources for \$1,250
 - Alien Inline for \$7,665



- Fish wall maintenance and supplies \$500
- Je Lis Subscription \$1,622; and
- Contingency for <u>only</u> approved budgeted items of \$1,500

Finally, please note that insurance spend is being requested to have an additional \$300 as premiums are increasing due to event size for the BBQ which was previously not contemplated by our insurer. Overall, if all funds were spent, we would be left with \$7,700 to start the 2024/25 school year. This amount may be higher if costs come in lower than anticipated for a couple of the items. The carry forward would be within rules to spend casino funds within 36 months of receipt. Further, we will continue to work with administration to see if any other programs could be funded and make a special budget request if this is the case.

As noted earlier in the bank balance update, we hold \$11,604 in the general account made up mostly of one-time donations, corporate donations, and an old GIC redemption. We are proposing to spend a sizeable amount of this cash during the year and requesting \$9,300 of the amounts allocated to "anything" funding for new musical instruments deemed high priority by Mr. Chapman and as discussed in the last meeting. We are looking to fund the expansion of the xylophones, including stands, as well as expanding the range for both the contrabass bars and the tone chimes. The estimated request is on the higher end of the range put forth by administration.

Further, we'll look to allocate the money for reading, technology, arts, and general enhancements as follows:

- We have \$371.68 for home reading and Danielle has priced out two box sets of the Wings of Fire series for \$350. The school only has one set of the books, and they are quite popular amongst the students.
- We have \$677 for technology of which we have allocated \$410 for headsets, audio splitters, and 2 apple adaptors. The remainder will be allocated to other items throughout the year.
- Finally, we have \$287 and \$125 for arts and general enhancements and will work to spend this during the year based on requests from administration or carry it forward to next year.

Overall, the request will be for \$10,760 and would leave us with \$844 remaining in the general account based on today's balance; however, we are expecting approximately \$2,000 to come in from corporate donations and any straggling one-time donations.
